SECTION 4 FIRST AID MEASURES

EYE EXPOSURE: Immediately flush the eyes with copious amounts of water for at least 15 minutes. Assure flushing under eyelids. A victim may need assistance in keeping their eyelids open. Get immediate competent medical attention.

ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS: Prevent spillage from entering drains or allowing to be released into the environment.

METHODS AND MATERIALS FOR CONTAINMENT AND CLEANING UP: Cover spill in sodium carbonate or dolomite to reduce dust formation. Sweep up and place in suitable container for proper disposal.

SECTION 7 HANDLING AND STORAGE

PRECAUTIONS FOR SAFE HANDLING: Wear appropriate personal protective equipment. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Use with adequate ventilation. Avoid formation of dusts and aerosols. Keep away from sources of ignition – No smoking. Take measure to prevent the build up of electrostatic charge. Handle under dry protective gas. Reacts violently with water to produce flammable gases.

CONDITIONS FOR SAFE STORAGE: Store in cool, dry well ventilated area. Store under dry inert gas. Store away from air, water, moisture, oxidizing agents, halogens, and acid chlorides.
